- Tell me about yourself.
- Walk me through your resume.
- What is your greatest professional accomplishment to date?

- What leadership roles have you played in school, at work, or in the community?
- Describe a situation where true teamwork was the best way to reach a goal.
- Have you ever encountered people who thought and acted different from you? What viewpoints of theirs challenged you the most? How did you respond? What did you learn about yourself and others?
- Share a personal strength. Provide an example of how you have leveraged this strength on the job or in the classroom.
- Share a personal area of improvement/development.

- What is your approach to meeting new people? Describe how you might typically behave around your teachers or other adults in your life vs. your friends and peers?
- Where do you see yourself in 2 years, 5 years, 10 years?
- How would a supervisor (or professor) describe you?
- What's one aspect of your previous company's culture that you hope to bring to your next one? What one aspect do you hope to not find?
- What trends and developments are happening in the global economy and marketplace that may have an impact on this industry? How are you preparing for the changing global landscape?
